Itinerary: Travel to Finch Hatton to the Criterion Hotel for lunch. After lunch enjoy a Bushwalk through the rainforest to Finch Hatton Gorge, a wonderful landscape of waterfalls, lush flora and volcanic boulder formations make Finch Hatton Gorge a must-see attraction. The granite boulders and surrounding vegetation make this an ideal place to take in the scenery. Keep an eye out among the rainforest for rare and unusual flora and fauna, such as the rare gastric brooding frog, the orange-sided skink, Mackay tulip oak, Eungella spiny cray and Eungella honeyeater. ****Please note suitable walking shoes will be required for the hike.***

Enroute from Finch Hatton you will make your way up into the clouds to Eungella to stop in at the Historical Eungella Chalet – Enjoy some afternoon tea (at your own expense) with an amazing view over the Pioneer Valley.

From the Eungella Chalet you will take a short drive to Sky window look out for a leisurely walk to admire more amazing views of the Pioneer Valley before travelling on to Broken River to spot Platypus and some freshwater turtles.

- Platypus spotting at Broken River.
- Discovery of amazing flora and fauna.
- An interpretive walk in Finch Hatton Gorge.
- Spectacular scenic views of the Pioneer Valley from the Eungella Range at 2,400 feet

Sarina Sugar Shed is a multi-award-winning attraction that offers a genuine and authentic paddock-to-plate food tourism experience and showcases the rich heritage of the sugar cane industry in Queensland.

Through their daily guided tours, Sarina Sugar Shed celebrates the achievements of the sugar cane pioneers who brought great prosperity to the region through their back-breaking work and mechanical ingenuity, and then, via their miniature mill, they demonstrate the process of taking the raw

sugar cane plant and turning it into both crystallised sugar ready for refining and ethanol for alcohol production.

The journey ends with tastings of the products that they produce which highlight the many delicious uses of sugar, including rum, rum liqueurs and fruit liqueurs made onsite in the boutique distillery, plus their range of Chefs' Gusto chutneys, relishes and sauces, and non-alcoholic ginger beer.
